# Jesus shows us that as King over all...

## 1. v28-30 He KNOWS our hearts.

(**Jeremiah 17:9-10**) The human heart is the most deceitful of all things, and desperately wicked. Who really knows how bad it is? But I, the Lord, search all hearts and examine secret motives. I give all people their due rewards, according to what their actions deserve.

(1 Timothy 1:12) "I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has given me strength to do his work. He considered me trustworthy and appointed me to serve him."

Because of Jesus, we DON'T HAVE TO HIDE.

# 2. v31 He **SEES** our true actions.

(**Hebrews 4:13**) Nothing in all creation is hidden from God. Everything is naked and exposed before his eyes, and he is the one to whom we are accountable.

(James 2:14,17,19,26) What good is it if you say you have faith but don't show it by your actions? Can that kind of faith save anyone? So you see, faith by itself isn't enough. ### 3. v31b-32 He NEVER GIVES UP on us.

Will God ever give up on us because...

- we have sinned too much? **NO** (Rom 5:20)
- we struggle with the same sin? <u>NO</u> (Mt 18:22)
- we feel like failures? **NO** (Rom 3:23)
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- we have given up on ourselves? <u>NO</u> (Num 23:19)

(Romans 8:38-39) I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God's love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of hell can separate us from God's love. No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, NOTHING IN ALL CREATION WILL EVER be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord.
